# **PROGRAM NOTES**

The Alexandria Choral Society joyfully embarks on a musical journey across the Celtic nations, celebrating our 55th anniversary season with performances in Ireland and Scotland, including our sister city of Dundee, Scotland.

Our program weaves together sacred and secular traditions, bridging American and Celtic musical heritage.

The concert opens with timeless spiritual selections, from the ethereal "Hark, I Hear the Harps Eternal" to Fauré's beloved "Cantique de Jean Racine," and Mendelssohn's "Lift Thine Eyes" from Elijah. Contemporary spiritual works like "Let the Life I've Lived Speak for Me" and "Hope is the Thing with Feathers" reflect our modern American sacred music traditions.

The program celebrates maritime connections between our nations through Masefield's "Sea Fever" and the haunting American folk song "Shenandoah," acknowledging the ocean voyages that connected these cultures. Craig Hella Johnson's "Meet Me Here" from Considering Matthew Shepard demonstrates our commitment to meaningful contemporary repertoire addressing social justice issues.

American spirituals and freedom songs form the program's emotional core, including "Freedom" from Washington Women, and "Take Me to the Water," representing the African American musical tradition that profoundly influenced American choral music. These selections honor the struggle for civil rights while celebrating the transformative power of community singing.

The Celtic portion embraces traditional Scottish and Irish melodies: "Wild Mountain Thyme," "Red is the Rose," and "Parting Glass" offer warm recognition of local musical heritage. Stephen Paulus's "The Road Home" and Shawn Kirchner's "The Unclouded Day" provide contemplative moments, while Carly Simon's "Let the River Run" and "Sing, Sing, Sing" energize the program with contemporary American optimism.

This diverse repertoire reflects ACS's mission to build bridges through music, celebrating shared humanity while honoring distinct cultural traditions across the Atlantic. In our challenging political times, when division seems to dominate discourse, we believe music offers a powerful antidote—a universal language that transcends borders and reminds us of our common hopes and dreams. Through this Celtic journey, we seek to strengthen the bonds between our communities, demonstrating that cultural exchange and mutual understanding remain essential pathways to unity and peace.



Kathryn Harsha holds a

Piano Performance from

Paris, she served as
Assistant Conductor of the
Chorale des Étudiants

Etrangères and studied conducting at the Conservatoire Messiaen in Saint-Maurice, France.

An active conductor in choral, opera, and orchestral music, Ms. Harsha has worked with ensembles across the country, conducting most recently in Severance Hall and the Kennedy Center, and in France, Italy, Austria, and Germany. Kathryn served for many years as Music Director and Conductor of the Lakeland Civic Orchestra in Cleveland, Ohio, and as the Music Director of Opera per Tutti, now the Cleveland Opera Theater. For more than 20 years, she was the Music Director of the Sing Out! for Cleveland Rape Crisis Center benefit concert, where the Visionary Voice Award was named in her honor in 2018.

Ms. Harsha enjoys working with musicians of all ages, including young people at the Peabody Children's Chorus and Opus Community Music School, and mature singers at Encore Creativity for Older Adults, where she is currently the Interim Artistic Director and conducts multiple ensembles across the Washington metropolitan area.
