

On Sunday, October 26, join the Alexandria Choral Society as we kick off our 56th season with *Do You Hear What I Hear?*, a performance presented in partnership with the Alexandria Children's Chorus that asks audience members to contemplate the profound art of listening—not just with their ears, but with their hearts, minds, and spirits.

Singers of all ages will journey together through pieces that explore sound and the spaces in between. From the haunting introspection of Paul Simon's *The Sound of Silence* to the powerful resilience of Paul Caldwell and Sean Ivory's *Ain't No Grave*, each selection offers a different lens through which to experience the act of listening. In addition, we are excited to partner with student performance interpreters from Gallaudet University, who will be interpreting multiple pieces in ASL.
